Hyundai expects sales momentum to continue

Hyundai Motor India Ltd expects its sales momentum to sustain beyond the festive season due to pent-up demand, but said a second wave of coronavirus and a weak economy could act as a spoilsport.

The unit of Korea's Hyundai Motor Co. posted 30% year-on-year jump in sales during the 10-day Navratri period, and expects sales to surge during Diwali next week.

Ever since the lockdown measures were eased, Hyundai reported steady rise in vehicle sales thanks to robust demand for its Venue and Creta sport-utility-vehicle models. The two products propelled Hyundai to eclipse Maruti Suzuki as the largest sport utility vehicle (SUV) maker in the April-September period.

Hyundai expects sales to accelerate during the festive period with the launch of the new-generation model of the 120 premium hatchback on Thursday. Tarun Garg, director, marketing and sales, Hyundai Motor India, said there is huge pent-up demand as customers were delaying purchases since 2019, due to the confusion over the transition from Bharat Stage-IV to BS-VI emission standard media companies.

"Sales in October was the highest for us and there is high pent-up demand in the market. We had around 30% year-on-year growth in sales during Navratri, and Diwali should be equally good. The new 20 will also add to the volumes. This festive season has been very good in terms of demand and customer preference towards personal mobility is also pushing sales," Garg said.

JPC quizzes Uber, Ola over data, investments

Panel seeks answers from cab-hailers about steps taken to secure privacy

The joint parliamentary committee (JPC) on Thursday questioned app-based cab-hailers Ola and Uber on their investment pattern and transfer of critical data.

The JPC members asked Ola and Uber representatives about the steps they have taken to mine and secure data, while pointing out past instances of hacking, when the companies were fined.

"Both the companies agreed about data localization, but they also wanted clarification on critical sensitive data transfer and mining of data," said a person aware of the developments, seeking anonymity.

Panel members also asked the two companies to provide their investment patterns in writing.

Members wanted to know about the possibility of an incident of data hacking. Thereby would be sent in writing by the representatives of the two companies," he added.

As the app-based cab aggregators often ask for sensitive personal data, such as the details of the customer's or rider's Aadhaar number, they were questioned on how safe their data security arrangements were.

The JPC on personal data protection bill has been engaging with a number of digital and social media companies.

Over the past fortnight, the committee has engaged with the representatives of Google, Paytm, Twitter, Facebook, Amazon and Jio to discuss various aspects of the personal data protection bill, besides trying to understand the provisions on data safety, privacy and investment patterns, among other issues.

According to a second person, also seeking anonymity, the parliamentarians

questioned the cab hiring companies about the storage of data in their systems, and what was the provision for deleting such personal data.

"They gave a presentation related to different aspects of data protection. The question of storage of data and data local-

ization remained unanswered.

The parliamentary committee will be meeting for the third day this week on Friday and has summoned representatives of telecom company Bharti Airtel Ltd and call identification app Truecaller to seek their views on issues related to the personal data protection bill.

The Personal Data Protection Bill, 2019, was introduced in the Lok Sabha last December, and seeks to establish a Data Protection Authority. Amid concerns from lawmakers over citizens' right to privacy, it was sent to the joint parliamentary committee.
