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

- Wind Power Generation plant of the Company located at Village Hansua, District Jaisalmer, Rajasthan is not in operation as operating cost demanded by the service provider is higher than the generation of the revenue from the plant and at present the segment is not financially viable. However, the effect of this segment is very marginal on overall revenue of the Company. Further, the Company is negotiating with the Service Provider for reducing the operating cost of the plant and hopeful for the same.
- The figures of last quarter are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of the full financial year and the published year to date figures up to the third quarter of the current and previous financial years.
- The figures for the previous period has been regrouped / reclassified, wherever necessary in order to conform to the current grouping.
